Kitchen linens: 2 towels, 1 dish cloth, 1 Kitchen tongs

sponge, 2 pot holders Utility (medium sized) knife

Spatula/lifter Paring knife
Cooking spoon Peeler
Slotted cooking spoon Pizza cutter
Potato masher Measuring cups
Wire whisk Measuring spoons

Rubber spatula Bag clips

Can opener

(Package all items in jumbo zip lock bag, labeled "Kitchen Starter Kit - Wash before using)

TOOL KIT

Hammer (not too large) Small baggie or container of assorted screws

Screw drivers: Phillips head and flat head and nails
Pliers – needle nose and regular Picture hangers
Measuring tape

(Package all in a large or jumbo-sized Ziploc bag, and label)

SEWING KIT

Thread – several colors Variety of buttons (sizes and colors)

Needles Small scissors
Pins Safety pins

Measuring tape

(Place in small decorative tin or box with label, "Sewing Kit")

TOWEL KIT

One bath towel One wash cloth

One hand towel

(Tie all up like a package with ribbon or twine)
